Key Messages from Natasha and Fraser

- We are still following advice from the Ministry of Health and Education.
 - At this point the advice is that we are not to expect widespread school closures. Consequently any decisions about school
 closures will be made on a case by case basis.
 - o In the meantime, unless students are unwell themselves, then parents should keep sending them to schools and early learning centres as these environments continue to be safe and the best place for them to continue their learning.
 - Our school nurse, Catherine, is updating our school website regularly with clear advice. Please find a direct link here to all our communications.
 - Talking to children and young people about COVID-19
 - Given the rise in the number of reported cases, there may be children or young people in your life who experience distress. As a trusted adult, you can help reassure and educate them about COVID-19 it can be good to talk to them now, so they can understand the illness and be reassured.

- Schoology will be a very important space for us to ensure your child/ren have access to learning.
